

Help! My cat's been stung by a bee

Remove the sting

If your cat gets stung by a bee, quickly remove the sting. Use a credit card or similar object to scrape it out, being careful not to push more venom into the wound.

Treat the sting

To reduce swelling, gently apply an ice pack or a wrapped cold compress to the affected area.

Monitor your cat

After removing the sting, closely monitor your cat. They should recover fairly quickly. However, if you notice any of the following signs, seek emergency veterinary care:

- Slow or heavy breathing
- Signs of anaphylactic shock
- Cold limbs
- Pale or blue gums
- Persistent swelling
- Vomiting
- Excessive drooling
