

# How to remove a tick from a dog

Ticks are similar in appearance to a grain of rice (insert image of tick), a blister or a wart and they love little nooks and crannies. Give your dog a rub down after every walk, paying extra attention to their ears, muzzle, eyelids and under the chin. If you find a tick on your dog, follow our simple step by step instructions;

1



Buy a tick twister from your local vet

2



Get a friend to hold your dog still

3



Slide the tick twister under the tick with the prongs facing away from you until you feel pressure

4



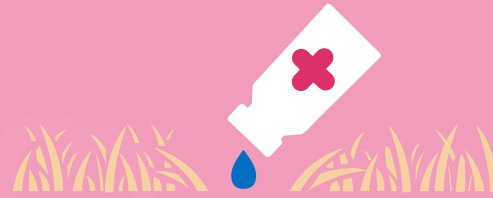
Gently twist the twister, keeping it flat on your dog's body until the tick lets go

5



Flush the tick down the toilet (they can't swim)

6



Clean and sanitise the bite area

7



Give your dog a big fuss
