

Five diseases your kitten's vaccines can prevent



- Feline herpesvirus and calicivirus
 These viruses cause cat flu, which can lead to serious breathing issues and, sometimes, longterm illness or death.
- Peline infectious enteritis
 This virus spreads easily, causing vomiting, diarrhoea, and dehydration, and can even be deadly.
- Feline leukaemia virus (FeLV)

 Weakens the immune system, putting cats at risk of severe infections and illnesses.

Non-core vaccines to consider

- Chlamydia felis
 Can cause painful eye infections, but not all cats are at risk your vet can advise if the vaccine is needed.
- Rabies
 The UK is rabies-free, but this virus is almost always fatal once symptoms appear a vaccine is needed if travelling abroad.
