Kennel cough symptoms



Persistent cough

A dry, hacking sound. Sometimes described as a choking or honking noise.



Gagging or retching

Dogs with kennel cough get lots of mucus in their throat which makes them gag.



Runny nose

In particular, watch out for clear or cloudy snot.



Red or watery eyes

Kennel cough can cause irritated red eyes, or discharge from the eyes.



Sneezing

Normally a sneeze is just a sneeze, but alongside other symptoms it often isn't.



Lethargy!

Kennel cough can make dogs unusually tired and reluctant to play.



Loss of appetite

Dogs who suddenly refuse to eat or drink may have a worsening infection.



Fever

Very high body temperature, sometimes with green or yellow nasal discharge.
